I. SPECIALISATION TRACK

There are three types of courses / modules in the English Studies Track:

1. **Foundation Modules** are compulsory. As some of these courses build on each other, it is important to take them in a specific order. Please note that some foundation courses contribute to *the interdisciplinary framework* and *related fields* (see Organisational Chart).

ECTS: 39

2. **Core Modules** make up the common basis of the English Studies track. Although all three modules have to be validated in full, some of these courses can be replaced by courses taken during the semester abroad.

ECTS: 24 + 12 (mobility)

3. **Elective Modules** allow us to increase the diversity of our offer. They are more specific and advanced. Elective modules will open when you choose the course as part of your *specialisation track* for 4 ECTS and close once you have obtained your 8 ECTS. Choosing a course as a *related field* (3 ECTS) does not open the module. Participation in these courses is limited. You must complete 2 elective modules.

II. INTERDISCIPLINARY AND RELATED STUDIES

The BACHELOR EN CULTURES EUROPEENNES includes a consciously interdisciplinary framework, in which you will be introduced to other disciplines in the humanities and social sciences, and encouraged to develop interdisciplinary approaches. In the related fields section of your programme, you are free to further explore other fields or to strengthen your specialisation in English literature and linguistics. The choice is yours!

1. **Interdisciplinary Modules:** Modules I-III propose introductions to a variety of fields. Modules IV-VI offer actively interdisciplinary approaches to a variety of topics and subjects. The English Studies Introductory Lectures Series (your L1) are part of the interdisciplinary framework for students in other fields, but are considered part of your specialisation track in English Studies.

2. **Related Fields:** with the exception of two courses (English for Academic Purposes and the Research Seminar), you are free to explore any field from the BCE or the *Open Courses* catalogue as part of your *Related Fields* module. Make sure you choose the (S) 3 ECTS version of the course. If you prefer, you can also choose to develop your focus on English Studies more strongly: in this case, you will have to choose the (S) 3 ECTS version of the course. This last option is only available for elective courses.
