The **Interdisciplinary Framework** (3 ECTS per course) provides general introductions to a variety of fields (Interdisciplinary Modules I-III) as well as targeted interdisciplinary lecture series and seminars (Interdisciplinary Modules IV-VI). Available courses are listed in the *Interdisciplinary Framework Guide* and can be found on Moodle using the Moodle Course ID prefixes given in the table above. Semesters 4+6: One seminar or lecture series per semester can be replaced by a practical workshop.

Except for the Introductory Lectures (Module I), **English Studies Track** courses are awarded 4 ECTS. The **Foundation Modules** (Modules I-V) are compulsory and must be completed in full. You must choose two **Core Modules** (the third can be validated during your semester abroad) and two **Elective Modules**. Please refer to your ECTS Checklist for further detail and make sure you fully validate the modules you choose.

Except the academic study skills courses (Modules IV and V), you are free to choose any course or subject, including English Studies, in the **Related Fields** section of your degree (in this case, you will be awarded 3 ECTS for English Studies courses). Make sure you choose the (S) Version of the course! Please note that English for Academic Purposes can be taken in Semester 1 or 2.
