The *Bachelor en Cultures Européennes* offers you the possibility to develop a **second disciplinary focus** (min. 36 ECTS) or a **second specialisation** (= *full minor/volles Nebenfach*: max. 60 ECTS) in one of the five main BCE Fields. This second specialisation may replace all non-mandatory EU Modules. According to the University Regulations you can earn up to 210 ECTS in a 180 ECTS Bachelor level degree. The maximum defined for the second specialisation is 60 ECTS. Depending on the EU Modules you choose, doing a full second specialisation (60 ECTS) means that you would graduate with a minimum of 192 ECTS. It can be more if you do more than the minimum required EU Modules. Please keep in mind that in order to graduate, you must complete all mandatory ('required') modules.

- EU Module 1 'Cultures Européennes: Lecture Series'** is compulsory for all BCE students. You will be able to choose courses in EU1 from Semester 3 onwards, and you can also use Interdisciplinary Seminars (Transversal Courses II / 8 ECTS) to validate credits in EU1.

**ECTS: 12**

- Second Disciplinary Focus or Specialisation – YEAR 1:** if you are planning to do a second disciplinary focus or specialisation in one of the other four BCE fields, please make sure you choose courses in that discipline from Modules EU2-4 in your first year. You will be able to apply to do a second disciplinary focus or specialisation at the end of Semester 2. The Board of Examiners will take your results in these courses into account in their evaluation of your application. This also means that you can familiarise yourself with these disciplines in your first year before you make your decision.

**ECTS: 12**

- Second Disciplinary Focus or Specialisation – YEAR 2 / Foundation:** each BCE Specialisation Track has defined compulsory foundation-level courses that are required for a second disciplinary focus or specialisation. The BCE Timetable has been designed to allow you to choose these courses in your second year. There should be no overlap. For non-mandatory courses, timetables have not been aligned. As you choose your courses, remember that your second disciplinary focus or specialisation modules remain open throughout.

**ECTS: defined by specialisation track**

- Second Disciplinary Focus or Specialisation – YEAR 2-3 / Advanced Level:** each BCE Specialisation Track has defined modules or courses from their offer that you can choose from freely. Please note that timetables have not been aligned and that there may be overlaps or timetable clashes. As you choose your courses, remember that your second disciplinary focus or specialisation modules remain open throughout.
